<i>Conversion</i>	John 3:3	Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

<i>Relationship with Christ/ Abide</i>	" 6:53	Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you.
<i>Life of Sin = Slavery</i>	" 8:34	Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin.
<i>Keep Word of God, No 2nd Death</i>	" 8:51	Verily, verily, I say unto you, If a man keep my saying, he shall never see death.
<i>Diety of Christ</i>	" 8:58	Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.
<i>Way to Life /Way to death</i>	" 10:1	Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that entereth not by the door into the sheepfold, but climbeth up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber.
<i>Christ Way of Life</i>	" 10:7	Verily, verily, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep.
<i>Death brings forth Resurrection</i>	" 12:24	Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

<i>spirit of Rejection - troubling</i>	" 13:21	When Jesus had thus said, he was troubled in spirit, and testified, and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, that one of you shall betray me.
<i>spirit of Denial</i>	" 13:38	Verily, verily, I say unto thee, The cock shall not crow, till thou hast denied me thrice.
<i>Christ's Disciples do His works</i>	" 14:12	Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater [works] than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.
<i>Weep / Lament/ Sorrow/ Joy</i>	" 16:20	Verily, verily, I say unto you, That ye shall weep and lament, but the world shall rejoice: and ye shall be sorrowful, but your sorrow shall be turned into joy.

*The two chapters in John this phrase was used the most was chapters 6 & 13. Chp 6 deals with the aftermath of the feeding of the 5000. We must drink in of Him and consume Him as we do our physical bread. Chp. 13 is dealing with the washing of the disciples feet and Lord's supper--the importance of brotherly love and unity. The last meeting Christ had with His disciples before His death. Here he emphasised the importance of each having a love (agape love) one for another--being united together in the love Christ. In 14-16 He emphasized the importance of this in different ways, since this involved His discussion around the table and then on their way to the Garden of Gethsemene.*

*Thus we see in these two chapters, the summary of all the rest. We must have the daily abiding experience with Christ (1st great commandment) and then we love one another as we should (2nd great commandment)*
