A PRACTICAL REVIEW OF REVELATION

Could it be that we are experiencing a continual revealing, an unfolding of the character of Christ, as we continue looking and study this amazing Book? We will again be looking at the SOP Statements from last week in light of this review. We will begin to see things differently.

We will be bringing out of [this] "treasure things new and old," as Jesus described of the Kingdom of Heaven in Matthew 13:52.

OUTLINE

- We will be looking at the purpose of the book summarized in chapter 1.
- We also will be analyzing what the Revelation of Jesus is on a practical level. {Testimony time: How has it impacted your life personally}
- Seven Churches are examined and extended a Hand inviting them onward to victory. We will consider this from both perspectives— The Judgment of the Dead & The Judgment of the Living
- The opening of the Seven Seals (Chp 6 & 8.1) we've come to know as the process of the Investigative Judgment of God's people (examining "the books of the Seven Churches"). Though the word "Judgment" does not appear until chp 14, we will view this from a new frame of reference involving the character of God in relation to His people.
- Because the book of Revelation is saturated with Sanctuary language, it is vital we recognize this not only in understanding the book, but applying the principles to our lives that we may overcome in Judgment.

This Revelation of Jesus has much more for us to consider, with a number of points —things old and new—the Lord has shed light on for our admonition, which we just didn't have time to cover. We will look at these in review fashion in a future lesson.
