Judgment of the Living

A <u>lest coming suddenly</u>, He find you sleeping I say unto all, Watch!

This passage in Mark 14:33-37, refers to the Close of Probation. See 2T 190, 191 & 205.2. Thus we Jesus informing us of the importance of watching and praying, individually. {The word "ye" indicates individual.} The 'Judgment of the Living' is a process that could end abruptly. If we watch and are prepared, even if our life ends early, we will be sealed for eternity. But if we don't watch and tragedy comes, our lives will end abruptly and we will be lost. How tragic when Christ has given us amply warning. Will we not watch?
