Since this Psalm speaks of Jesus, predominantly as do all the psalms, then the core of the passage, the pinnacle thought would reveal that the "Right Hand" of the Lord is none other than the Son of Man, the Victorious Christ.

The pinnacle thought is truly 'chiastic' in that it is in the shape of an X, from which the word 'chiasm' originates.
