

SUPPLEMENT – “Till” / “UNTIL”
DANIEL 7

The word “till” and “until” has special significance in re. to the Judgment here in Daniel 7. Let us analyze each case here:

- 1) Vs.4 – Since the Lion symbolizes Babylon, there seems to be a two-fold application here:
 - a) The “recovery/conversion of Nebuchadnezzar” after God humbled him...
“made stand upon the feet as a man and man’s heart given him.”
 - b) The “fall of Babylon” when Darius (Medo-Persians) overcame it.
“wings were plucked” and “lifted up from the earth”

Dan 7:4 The first *was* like a lion, and had eagle's wings: I beheld **till** the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it.

Daniel beheld these four beasts until the Judgment began in 1844

Dan 7:9 I beheld **till** the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment *was* white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne *was like* the fiery flame, *and* his wheels *as* burning fire.

Dan 7:11 I beheld then because of the voice of the great words which the horn spake: I beheld *even* **till** the beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame.

The angel Gabriel continues to show Daniel what happens all the way until the end of time. Is this before the Second Coming or after? (see Rev.19:20 cf Rev 20:10) _____

Dan 7:22 **Until** the Ancient of days came, and judgment was given to the saints of the most High; and the time came that the saints possessed the kingdom.

When does this happen? _____

Dan 7:25 And he shall speak *great* words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand **until** a time and times and the dividing of time.
